Course Description:

This course is conducted in an independent study style online program through OddysseyWare and is an opportunity to improve past grades, receive credit for graduation, or both. All coursework must be completed as prescribed by the end of the semester in order to receive a passing grade. *Students are expected to be self-motivated, disciplined, and practice effective time management in order to maximize their success*. Students should anticipate completing **AT LEAST ONE** assignment each day in order to be successful.

Course Structure:

Lessons

Within each unit are numerous lessons. Students will be expected to:

- Read and take notes from each lesson (see class notebook)
- Complete review questions at the end of each lesson with a score greater than 70%
- Repeat the lesson when a score of less than 70% is achieved with a maximum of 10 attempts

Projects (point values varies)

Projects are assigned throughout each unit. Students are expected to:

- Complete and submit projects as assigned
- Contact the instructor with any questions or concerns.

Quizzes (point values varies)

After 3-4 lessons have been completed, students will be assigned a quiz to review the lessons. Students will be expected to:

- Use the notes taken during the lesson to answer the quiz questions.
- Maximum of 5 attempts to achieve a 70% or better

Tests (point values varies)

Tests are assigned at the end of each unit and upon completion of the projects. Students are expected to:

- Use the notes taken during the lesson to answer the test questions.
- Maximum of 5 attempts to achieve a 70% or better

Virtual Meetings (20 points/meeting)

Students are required to attend at least 4 virtual meetings via Adobe Connect per semester. Each meeting can last up to an hour. Make sure you check your email regularly for links to the meetings and/or changes. Should a scheduling conflict arise, please contact the instructor immediately so that proper arrangements can be made.
